This day was combined with the Year 6 entrepreneurial challenge where teams of pupils came up with ideas to raise funds alongside the Year 8 activities and so we had lemonade stands, raffles galore and 'beat the goalie' competitions. Some of the teachers took part too, with stints in the stocks with gleeful children throwing wet sponges at them. Most spectacular of all was the Colour Run which turned

the pupils and the school fields into a rainbow cloud of pastel shades.



Finally, we bade farewell to our Year 8 leavers to whom I pay tribute as a fabulous group of young people who have contributed so much to the life of our school. We wish them well for the next stage in their school lives.





The range comprises three gins: LDG, a traditional London gin; OTG, a spicy Old Tom gin and BST, a fragrantly floral summer gin.


