Notes on suggested costumes:

Medieval - year 8 (black, grey and white)

Any form of grey or white top, and any kind of black skirt, trousers or shorts.

Dresses in grey, white or black may also be worn.

Medieval - year 7 (black, brown and white)

Any form of brown or white top, and any kind of black skirt, trousers or shorts.

Dresses in black, brown or white may also be worn.

WW1 - year 6 (black and red)

Any form of red top and any kind of black skirt, trousers or shorts.

Dresses in red or black may also be worn.

Tudor - year 5 (black and green)

Any form of green top and any kind of black skirt, trousers or shorts.

Dresses in black or green may also be worn.

All classes: normal shoes for PE - trainers or plimsolls for comfortable movement
