Join us on Saturday 28 March for a day of meeting the curators and family friendly workshops, and be among the first to explore the changes we've made whilst the museum has been closed.

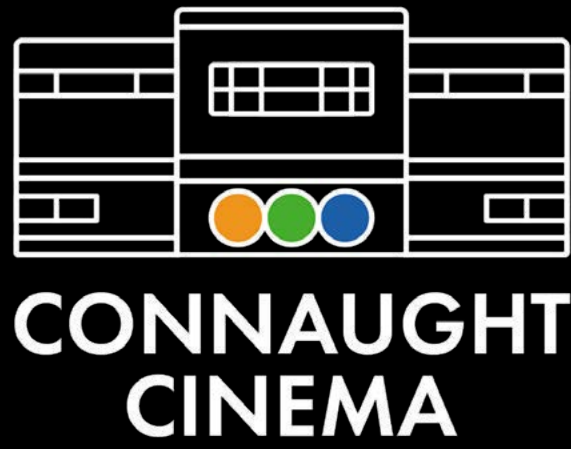

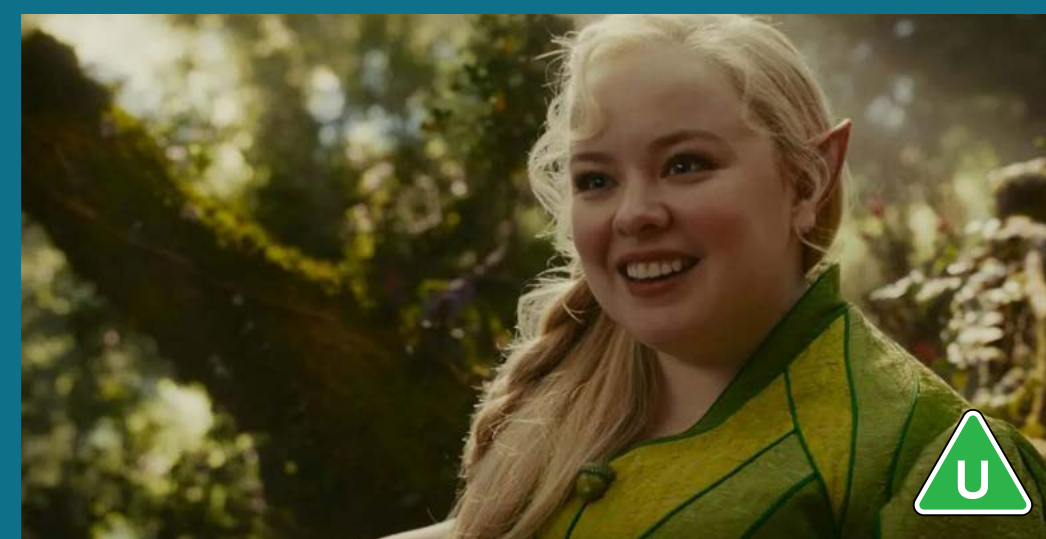
