Dear OLs

I am writing to tell you about some changes that the College has recently agreed with The Old Lancing Club in the form of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). The objective of this agreement is to ensure the widest sense of collaboration across the Lancing community.

You may, or indeed, may not be aware that you are one of 2,500 OLs who are not registered as members of The OL Club. This would have happened either as you had elected not to become a member or because your parents chose not to subscribe to The OL Club in your time as a pupil at the College. In the light of the recent Memorandum of Understanding signed between the College and The OL Club, we felt it was important to be fully inclusive of all OLs and in everyone's interest to build and develop the wider OL community.

What does this mean for you?

- You will become a member of The OL Club automatically, unless you inform us that you would prefer not to. There will be no subscription fee to pay.
- You will be invited to all events run by The OL Club including the Summer Reception, the Christmas Carol Service and the annual Club Dinner
- You will continue to receive all the College communications from the Foundation Office and be invited to all Foundation and OL Club events.

The new MOU means that there will be ever closer links between our two organisations and you may have already noticed more significant coverage of The OL Club in The Quad magazine; there will also be joint planning and hosting of more events and activities all aimed at bringing former school friends together.

We hope that you will approve of this development and look forward to seeing you soon.
