



Accessibility - Frequently asked questions

I am a blue badge holder. Will I be able to park in the car park?

Car parking spaces will be reserved for Blue Badge holders and others with access needs. Allocated spaces will be on a first-come first-served basis.

How far is the walk from the car parks to the artisan market?

The walk from the car parks range from 100 metres to 400 metres depending on where you are parked. The walk involves uphill and downhill walking consisting of tarmac and gravel. Parking spaces cannot be reserved and are allocated upon arrival.

Will there be a designated accessible entrance for the artisan market?

Due to the design and age of the buildings regrettably there is no step free access to the artisan markets. The farmers market is accessible and so is the Chapel. If we experience inclement weather then the farmers market will be placed inside and will not be accessible.

Are there accessible toilets?

Accessible toilets are available at the front of the venue, opposite the Chapel. There are no accessible toilets available within the proximity of the farmers and artisan market.

Is the Vintage Bus accessible for wheelchair users or visitors with limited mobility?

Unfortunately, due to the vintage design of the vehicle, it is not equipped to accommodate wheelchairs.
